## Relevance or Qualifying Body Statement - The Localism Act 2011.

Maghull Town Council is the organisation applying for designated area status for the purposes of developing a Neighbourhood Plan for the town of Maghull. Maghull Town Council is the "relevant /qualifying body" in making the application for the area delineated by the boundaries of Maghull (please see map attached) under the following criteria:

"For the purposes of a neighbourhood development order, a parish (town) council are authorised to act in relation to a neighbourhood area if that area consists of or includes the whole or any part of the area of the council." Localism Act 2011, Schedule 9, Section 61F.
