




School Streets Plot Background

 - Greenbank High School
 - Stanley High School


- Working with Sustrans to deliver curriculum linked activities and modules
- Community Coproduction
- Strong focus on youth voice

Pilot seeks to tackle, road safety & congestion concerns, promote independent travel



Progress so far - Stanley High School

- Big Street Survey undertaken with two classes
- Manifesto developed
- Collaborative design Session with the young people
- Wider student body engagement
- Engagement with residents / Parents on 2 plans




- Unsafe due to fast cars
- Extend the yellow zig-zags
- Add double yellow lines
 - Add speed cameras
 - Add speed carrieras
 Add crossing points
 - Cars on the pavement



Marshside Rd:

- Change the speed limit
- Fast road/cars drive fast
 - It's busy
 - Add crossings
 - It's boring
 - It's unsafe
 - Add artwork


Further engagement with stakeholders and young people

Progress so far – Birkdale High School & Greenbank High School

- Big Street Survey undertaken at both schools
- Manifesto developed by the young people and ratified by wider student body
- In school engagement on curriculum related topics
- Resident / Staff and Stakeholder Survey
- 'Meet the Project Team' events

Post decision to trial a school street

- Further meet the Project Team Sessions
- Door Knocking to talk to residents and offer vehicle permits
- Drop off and pick up conversations with parents in both streets to raise awareness of the start date.
- Joint School Council Convened






Community Consultation Results - Greenbank High School & Birkdale High School –


High level of support expressed by residents during the engagement process

Do you support introducing a School Street at Birkdale High School?




Do you support introducing a School Street at Greenbank High School?




Travel to School - Birkdale High School and Greenbank High School
