Supplementary Planning Document

Sefton Metropolitan Borough Council adopted the Green Space, Trees and Development Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on 31st July 2008. The SPD supplement policies contained within the adopted Sefton Unitary Development Plan (June 2006)

This document forms part of the Development Plan for Sefton and will be used to inform decisions on land use planning affecting the area. The SPD replaces the Trees and Development SPG and Public Greenspace and Development SPG.

The proposals came into operation on 10 July 2008. Any person aggrieved by the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the SPD. Such an application must be made promptly and in any event not later than three months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
