The categories of this information that we collect, process, hold and share include:

- Personal information (name, address, email address and telephone numbers)
- Terms of office as school governor
- Attendance at Governing Body meetings
- Attendance at training events
- Employment details and skills relevant to the application or role as a school governor
- Special category of personal information (Race, ethnicity or political opinions)
- Disability and access requirements.

Why we collect and use this information

The Governor Services team use this information as follows:

- Providing advice, guidance and support to schools and Governing Bodies
- Maintaining a governor database
- Relevant training and development opportunities
- Communication and correspondence relating to governor matters
- Nomination of Local Authority Governors
- Assessing and reporting on governor vacancies across the borough
- Planning future training requirements
- Equal opportunities monitoring
- Ensure that appropriate access arrangements can be provided as required.

The lawful basis on which we use this information

Article 6(1)(c) of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) 2018 gives the Council a lawful basis for collecting and using personal data in order to comply with its legal obligations and Article 6(1)(e) gives the Council a lawful basis for collecting and using personal data where it is in the exercise of official authority vested in the Council.

There are a number of pieces of legislation which place duties on the Local Authority to appoint, provide training and support governors. These are:

- School(s) to which you may be considered for appointment as a governor
- Other departments within the Local Authority who are supporting schools and their Governing Bodies
- Democratic Services (in respect of information relating to councillors serving on Governing Bodies)
- Human Resources (in relation to governor staffing responsibilities)
- School Improvement Service (to support governing bodies and support Ofsted inspections)
- Children, Schools and Safeguarding Cabinet Member
- Suppliers and service providers (e.g. CAPITA, Frontline data) to enable them to provide the service we have contracted them for, such as governor/trustee support.

Requesting access to your personal data
