COVID-19 Testing update

We are pleased to be able to let you know that 571 people were tested during the three days the military were at Southport last week; with a total of 2490 people being tested in the borough so far. The military pop-up testing site will be back in the borough for three days this week (3rd, 4th and 5th June) at Litherland Sports Centre, to provide clinical diagnosis tests that tell people if they currently have the Covid-19 virus.
