Affirmation of Competence to undertake Periodic Inspection, Testing and Certification of Electrical Installations

As a 'Local Housing Authority', Sefton MBC (Housing Standards Team) must ensure that 'Electrical Inspection Condition Report/s' (EICRs), submitted in connection with:

• Housing licensing applications under Parts 2 & 3 of 'The Housing Act 2004' (Mandatory HMO, Additional HMO and Selective licensing)

or in compliance with;

 Regulation 3 (1) of 'The Electrical Safety Standards in the Private Rented sector (England) Regulations 2020' (SI 312:2020)

<u>and</u>

 Regulation 7 (3) of 'The Licensing and Management of Houses in Multiple Occupation (Additional Provisions) (England) Regulations 2007' (SI 1903:2007) – as applicable to <u>'Section 257 HMOs'</u>,

has / have been produced by a person both qualified and specifically competent to undertake inspection and testing of fixed electrical installations.

In line with current government guidance, the Local Housing Authority (LHA) may do this by:

- checking if the inspector is a member of a relevant competent person scheme, via the 'Registered Competent Person Electrical' website: <u>Home (electricalcompetentperson.co.uk)</u> and / or
- 2. "requiring the inspector to sign a checklist certifying their competence, including their experience, whether they have adequate insurance and hold a qualification covering the current version of the wiring regulations and in the periodic inspection, testing and certification of electrical installations".

Sefton Council <u>strongly recommends</u> that you use an electrical inspector that is a member of a relevant competent person scheme and is <u>specifically registered for electrical</u> <u>inspection & testing</u> (please see 'Advice to Landlords on commissioning an EICR').

If you choose to use an electrical inspector that is <u>not</u> specifically registered for electrical inspection & testing, then you will need to provide us with written affirmation as to your inspector's competence to carry out inspection and testing of fixed electrical installations. You can do this by having them complete this form <u>and</u> sign the declaration regarding their competence. The signed and completed form should be included with any EICRs submitted to the authority and returned to the address given.

Please note that if the checklist and declaration are not suitably completed or returned, <u>or</u> if required information is missing, <u>or</u> any of the above list of competency requirements are not met, then we will <u>not</u> accept the EICR submitted.

In circumstances where submitted EICRs have been rejected, Sefton Council will still require you to provide a suitable EICR, which would incur additional cost to you. Sefton Council will not be liable for any such additional cost and the failure to provide a suitable EICR may result in enforcement action being taken.
