

FINANCIAL MATTERS – FACTSHEET 5

Adult Social Care Fees and Charges – 2026/27

This factsheet gives an overview of Adult Social Care fees and charges for 2026/27. Some charges are set nationally and some locally. Where your capital is £23,250 or below, a financial assessment will usually decide how much you pay.

Long term care home placements – weekly charge from 6 April 2026
